

ORDINANCE NO. 9-2017

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE 4-2012 OF THE VILLAGE OF BRADNER, WOOD COUNTY, OHIO AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, on or about June 7, 2012, this Council passed, as an Emergency Measure, Ordinance 4-2012 Setting Wages and Salaries For Village Pool Lifeguards and the Pool Manager; Establishing Fees and the Rules Governing Pool Membership, Admission and Rentals; and

WHEREAS, subsequent to the enactment of said Ordinance 4-2012, additional ordinances have been passed which conflict with said Ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BRADNER, WOOD COUNTY, OHIO:


Section 1. That Ordinance 4-2012 is hereby repealed in its entirety and shall be held for naught, having no effect or force in law.

Section 2. All formal actions of Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance and all deliberations of Council and any of its committees leading to such action were in meetings open to the public as required by Law.

Section 3. This ordinance constitutes an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of the Village of Bradner, and shall go into immediate effect upon the passage thereof. The reason for the emergency is that the pool is about to open and it is necessary to establish wages, salaries, fees, and rules so that the pool can be operated in a safe and efficient manner and the prior, conflicting ordinance would prevent the same from being lawfully accomplished.


Section 4. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time permitted by law.
