

ORDINANCE PROHIBITING ANIMAL DEFECATION ON PUBLIC OR PRIVATE PROPERTY

WHEREAS, the Village of Bradner, Ohio, desires to prohibit, by ordinance, animal defecation on public or private property.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BRADNER, WOOD COUNTY, OHIO:

SECTION 1:

That the Village of Bradner adopts the following:

- (a) No owner, keeper, or harborer of any dog, cat, or other animal shall knowingly permit the animal to defecate on the property, either public or private, of another without the owner, keeper, or harborer having in his possession the necessary tools or equipment to remove the defecation.
- (b) The owner, keeper, or harborer shall use the necessary tools and equipment to remove defecation from the property forthwith.
- (c) Any person who shall violate any provisions of this section shall be guilty of a minor misdemeanor and shall be fined not more than One-Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$150.00) for each offense.

SECTION 2:

All formal actions of Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance and all deliberations of Council and any of its committees leading to such action were in meetings open to the public as required by Law.
