**RESOLUTION TO HIRE TAX ADMINISTRATOR  
VILLAGE OF BRADNER, OHIO AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, on or about December 15, 2016, the Council of the Village of Bradner passed Ordinance No. 17-2016, establishing the position of Village Tax Administrator, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to said Ordinance 17-2016, the Village Tax Administrator is charged with certain duties and responsibilities relative to the collection and implementation of said Village Income Tax, and

WHEREAS, the Village is required by said Ordinance 17-2016 and Ordinance No. 14-2016 to fill the position of Village Tax Administrator; and

WHEREAS, Council of the Village of Bradner has determined that it is necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and welfare that the Village enact such regulation.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BRADNER, STATE OF OHIO, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Lizabeth Hirzel is hereby appointed to the position of Village Tax Administrator, upon such terms and conditions as may hereafter be prescribed by Council.

SECTION 2. The Village Tax Administrator shall fulfill all of the duties and obligations incumbent of that office as set-forth in Ordinance 14-2016, and any amendments thereto, and as otherwise required by law or rule, and is hereby vested with all rights, powers, and authority of said office.

SECTION 3. This ordinance constitutes an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of this Village, and shall go into immediate effect upon the passage thereof. The reason for the emergency is that the Tax Administrator must be appointed prior to January 1, 2017, and without declaring this legislation as an emergency, the Village would not be in compliance with law and would suffer financial harm.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall become effective from and after its passage at the earliest period allowed by Law.

SECTION 5. Copies of this Ordinance were posted in not less than five of the most public places in the Village, as determined by Council, for a period of not less than fifteen days prior to the effective date hereof.

SECTION 6. All formal actions of Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance and all deliberations of Council and any of its committees leading to such action were held in meetings open to the public, as required by Law.
