

RESOLUTION NO. 02-2018

**A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF
BRADNER, WOOD COUNTY, OHIO TO AMEND
RESOLUTION 17-2017 AND CORRECT THE SCRIVENER'S
ERROR TO ENACT CERTAIN PAY RAISES FOR THE
EMPLOYEES THEREOF**

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Bradner has certain employees under its direction and control and is empowered to manage and fix the compensation therefor; and

WHEREAS, after careful consideration and evaluation of the finances of the Village and the duties, qualifications, seniority, cost of living, and other relative factors related to said employees, Council determined that a pay raise and/or other financial remuneration was necessary and appropriate for said employees and passed Resolution 17-2017 enacting such raises on January 18, 2018; and

WHEREAS, Section 2(b) and Section 2(c) of said Resolution 17-2017 contained scrivener's errors with regard to certain pay rates; and

WHEREAS, Council seeks to correct said scrivener's errors.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BRADNER, WOOD COUNTY, OHIO:

Section 1. Section 2 of said Resolution 17-2017 is hereby amended to read as follows:

That, effective January 1, 2018, the following, current employees of the Village of Bradner shall receive a two percent (2%) increase of their rate of pay, calculated as of December 31, 2017, as more particularly set-forth in this section, below:

- a. Chief Chuck Broshious, new effective hourly rate of \$16.08 per hour.
- b. Sergeant Jeremy Salaz, new effective hourly rate of \$14.88 per hour.
- c. Detective Jamie Blausey, new effective hourly rate of \$14.31 per hour.
- d. Officer Jontez Moore, new effective hourly rate if \$11.34 per hour.

Section 2. The prior version of Section 2 of said Resolution 17-2017 is hereby repealed in its entirety, held for naught, and replaced wholly with the language hereinabove.

Section 3. All formal actions of Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution and all deliberations of Council to such action were in meetings open to the public as required by Law.

Section 4. That this Resolution shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time permitted by law.
