Community Development Block Grant:

Jim spoke with Denise at Poggemeyer. The Board needs to put together the funds they will supply toward the CDBG. The CDBG grant is \$288,000. The cap would be \$70,000 per project. The Board would possibly put \$35,000 toward the project. \$37,200 is set aside for engineering already. This will be used with the Critical Infrastructure grant which is \$300,000.

With the Verizon lease income, \$68,000 would be available at the end of the year in addition to the amount that comes in from utilities.

Jim would like to finish replacing 6" with 8" waterline down Timmons Rd. from Caldwell to the stub end. This leaves Stahl, Bell, East and Crocker. After Caldwell, about 60% of the town is done. 16,000 lineal feet is left to complete the entire project.

The Board had more discussion on this project.

The application has to be in by May 11.
