RESOLUTION NO. 05-2018

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BRADNER, WOOD COUNTY, OHIO TO CONTRACT WITH PERRY TOWNSHIP, WOOD COUNTY, OHIO FOR THE FURNISHING OF CERTAIN EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES TO SAID TOWNSHIP

WHEREAS, the Village owns, operates, and maintains an Emergency Medical Services (EMS) division of the Village Fire Department; and

WHEREAS, from time to time, the Village EMS provides services to adjacent service areas through mutual agreements, contract, or otherwise; and

WHEREAS, Perry Township, Wood County has no EMS services under its control, yet is obligated to provide such services to its residents; and

WHEREAS, the Village has continuously provided EMS services to Perry Township since at least 2003, with the last such written agreement for such services having expired November 16, 2005; and

WHEREAS, both the Village and Perry Township are desirous of maintaining the relationship which has existed since at least 2003 whereby the Village provides EMS services to Perry Township and Perry Township pays the Village for such services; and

WHEREAS, after extended and deliberate negotiation over terms of such a continued relationship, including price, payment, and liability incurred during the period of service for which no written contract governed, the Village and Perry Township seek to ratify the Ambulance Services Contact between the Village of Bradner and Perry Township.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BRADNER, WOOD COUNTY, OHIO:

- Services Contract by and between the Village and Perry Township, Wood County, Ohio (a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference) are acceptable to the Village and that the Village agrees to be bound thereby.
- Section 2. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute any and all such documents necessary to formalize said agreement.
- Section 3. All formal actions of Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution and all deliberations of Council to such action were in meetings open to the public as required by Law.

Section 4. That this Resolution shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time permitted by law.
