

RESOLUTION NO. 9-2018

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BRADNER, WOOD COUNTY, OHIO TO ADOPT THE WOOD COUNTY EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN

WHEREAS, pursuant to the requirements set forth in OAC 4501:3-3-01 and ORC 5502, et seq., the Village is required to create a local capability for emergency management; and

WHEREAS, the Village has heretofore contracted with the Wood County EMA as its local capability for emergency management; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village recognizes the threat which natural, human-caused, and technological hazards pose to people and property within the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Wood County EMA has prepared a multi-hazard mitigation plan known as the Wood County Hazard Mitigation Plan dated August 24, 2018 in accordance with the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000; and

WHEREAS, said Plan has been adopted by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA); and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village finds said Plan to be comprehensive and in the best interests of the residents and public within the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BRADNER, WOOD COUNTY, OHIO:

Section 1. The Village hereby adopts the Wood County Hazard Mitigation Plan, dated August 24, 2018, attached hereto and incorporated herein as "Exhibit A."

Section 2. That the members of Council and the Mayor are hereby authorized to execute any and all such documents necessary to formalize said agreement.


Section 3. All formal actions of Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution and all deliberations of Council to such action were in meetings open to the public as required by Law.

Section 4. That this Resolution shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time permitted by law.


