The joint meeting was called to order by Mayor Virgil Shull and all in attendance were asked to stand for the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag. Utility Superintendent John Linkey and Fiscal Officer Kerstan Kaminski were also present. Mike Gudakunst arrived at 7:01pm.

Engineering Services

Virgil finally received a call from Poggemeyer regarding the pool. He's been waiting for 3 weeks for a return call. The Board just found out about Critical Infrastructure grants this year from Poggemeyer when Bradner could have been applying in previous years. Northwest Water & Sewer also deals with Poggemeyer, per Greg, and they have issues with certain people at Poggemeyer as well. Poggemeyer has not gotten back regarding the Main St. project. It's been at least 8 weeks. Jim explained the recent issue with the Critical Infrastructure grant submission and the issues that came up with Poggemeyer. The first submission date was missed due to Poggemeyer not having all of the information ready and in on time. Bradner had to pull their application for CDBG since they didn't have the Critical Infrastructure. Now that the CDGB is every other year, Bradner only gets 2-3 shots at the grant for every 5 years. By the time CDBG

comes around again for Bradner, another income survey will have to be done. The Board and Council discussed the best way to go about this. The Board and Council agree they would like to see what other engineering firms can provide for Bradner.

Light Plant Roof

John Linkey has a quote for the Light Plant roof in the range of \$30,000-\$40,000 for regular shingle tear-off and replace, \$40,000-\$50,000 for barn steel (no tear-off) and \$60,000-\$70,000 for standing seam (no tear-off). Tear-off is \$2,000-\$3,000. The quote is for a 30 year shingle. Council and the Board discussed the 3 options and which might be best. They do not have to make a decision right now but need to be thinking about it to be done in the Spring. The Street Dept., Water and Electric all use the building.
