

AN ORDINANCE ALLOCATING THE FEES, FINES, AND COURT COSTS RECEIVED OF THE BRADNER MAYOR'S COURT

WHEREAS, the Village has exercised its authority pursuant to RC §1905.01 by establishing a Mayor's Court to hear misdemeanor criminal and traffic cases charged under ordinances of the Village; and

WHEREAS, in operating said Mayors Court, fees, fine monies, and court costs are regularly received of the Mayor's Court by the Village Fiscal Officer; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Revised Code provides for the specific allocation of some, but not all, of the fees, fines, and court costs received therefrom; and

WHEREAS, Council wishes to provide for the specific allocation of those monies received from the Village Mayor's Court not already specifically provided for by law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BRADNER, COUNTY OF WOOD, AND STATE OF OHIO:


SECTION 1. Any fees, fines, court costs, or other funds received of the Village Mayor's Court not otherwise specifically required by law to be specifically allocated shall be divided and allocated among the following funds in the respective proportion thereof:

- A. \$7.00 Per case to Police Capital Fund
- B. All remaining monies to the Village General Fund

SECTION 2. Copies of this Ordinance were posted in not less than five of the most public places in the Village, as determined by Council, for the period required by law.

SECTION 3. All formal actions of Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance, and all deliberations of Council and any of its committees leading to such action were in meetings open to the public as required by law.
