Pool/Park

Lori & Bill Schroeder would like to donate benches to the park and also asked about a placard. The committee talked about Ray building the benches cheaper. Benches are \$600/each and Ray could build them cheaper and have 10 of them for \$850-\$1,000. They will be bolted to a concrete pad as well. Lori and Bill can donate what they'd like toward the benches and placards will be placed on those benches.

Tammy Kreais made a motion to spend \$1,000 from the Park fund to build the benches around the pond. Shawn Hall 2nd.

The pool needs to be torn out and completely redone. It would cost around \$500,000. The pool will not be opened until further notice. The committee is looking into grants and possibly other options for the pool. They are also not going to try to fix the pump at this time. They will put dunks in the pool for the summer to prevent mosquitos.

Doug has been working in the park raking up leaves and picking up branches. Chuck R. can get out there now to mark where the new playground equipment will go and let the committee know so they can ok it.

Chuck R. brought up getting back by the pond and driving over the new walking path with heavy equipment. He would like to make a change so they don't have to drive over the asphalt and possibly ruin it.

Some more barrels need to be put around the walking path and pond for trash.

Tammy and Nicole L. will be going to North Branch to purchase the plants that were approved for the park.

OLD BUSINESS

There is not an ordinance in place that states hard billing vs soft billing. Corey wants a contract in place before writing up and ordinance. Kerstan will forward the email string with Corey's findings on Beacon.

RECOGNITION OF GUEST(S)

Theiden Taulker & Devon Eidenour: They would like to speak about getting state funding to help the Fire Dept. and Police Dept. Per Tom, the Fire Dept. gets 25-30 runs on 23 between Risingsun and Rt.6 per year yet Bradner does not receive any of those tax funds. Auxiliary Officers and Volunteer Firemen put their life on the line every day without pay. They are thinking of a different type of Block Watch that could do patrolling and the possibility of a Community Center. The Community Center could have a gym and charge for memberships. YMCA's may be able to help with the public pool as far as funding. The issue of the road conditions and saving money on widening the roads was also brought up. They would like to write a letter to the state regarding these issues in Bradner and would like to move forward as long as Council would approve and sign a letter of support.
