ORDINANCE NO. 23-97

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING THE DISPLAY OF STREET ADDRESS NUMBERS ON STRUCTURES WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF BRADNER.

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the Village legislative authority that there are a number of houses and other structures in the Village of Bradner that either do not display street address numbers on the structure, or display inadequate street address numbers on the structure, making it very difficult for emergency crews ,including police, fire and ambulance services to locate structures when an emergency arises, and a rapid response is required.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BRADNER, WOOD COUNTY, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the following shall be and the same is hereby adopted as Section 660,14 of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Bradner to be added to the General Offense Code of the Village of Bradner, Chapter 660 entitled "Safety, Sanitation and Health," to wit:

660.14 Display of Address; Number Size.

- (a) Every home and structure in the Village of Bradner located on a public right-of-way on which street addresses have been assigned, shall display the address number assigned to said structure in a legible manner. Said number shall be fixed in a conspicuous place on the front of the building and shall be visible from the public right-of-way. In case of a corner lot the number shall be fixed on the side facing the public right of way to which the number applies. The numbers shall be at least three inches in height.
- (b) Every owner, lessee, or occupant of any building shall properly number his building in accordance with this Section.
- (c) Whoever violates any provision of this Section is guilty of a minor misdemeanor. The penalty shall be as provided in 698.02.

SECTION II. That this Ordinance shall go into full force and effect at the earliest possible time allowed by law.
