## ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH THE WOOD COUNTY PUBLIC DEFENDER FOR THE REPRESENTATION OF INDIGENT PARTIES

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Ohio Constitution, The Ohio Revised Code, and the United States Constitution, criminal defendants, in most cases, are entitled to appointed counsel if they meet the indigency requirements; and

WHEREAS, absent a contractual agreement with the Wood County Public Defender, the Village must reimburse attorneys appointed by the court for indigent parties; and

WHEREAS, the Village has previously contracted with the Wood County Public Defender upon the same terms and conditions as set-forth below; and

WHEREAS, the Wood County Public Defender desires to provide services to those defendants who are cited under violations of only Village ordinances for the fee of one-hundred dollars (\$100.00) per case; and

WHEREAS, the Village desires to enter into such an agreement and finds the same to be fair and in the best interest of justice and necessary to protect the public health and peace.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BRADNER, COUNTY OF WOOD, AND STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Village enter into an agreement with the Wood County Public Defender (WCPD), whereby said WCPD will provide legal representation to indigent defendants cited only with violations of Bradner Ordinances for the sum of one-hundred dollars (\$100.00) per case.

SECTION 2. The Mayor shall be authorized to sign on behalf of the Village to bind the Village in such an agreement, and to execute any and all documents necessary for the consummation of such relationship.

SECTION 3. The term of the agreement shall be from January 1, 2021 through December 31, 2021.

SECTION 4. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after January 1, 2021.

SECTION 5. Copies of this Ordinance were posted in not less than five of the most public places in the Village, as determined by Council, for a period of not less than fifteen days prior to the effective date hereof.

SECTION 6. All formal actions of Council relating to the adoption of this ordinance, and all deliberations of Council and any of its committees leading to such action were in meetings open to the public as required by law.

## AGREEMENT RENEWAL FOR WOOD COUNTY PUBLIC DEFENDER SERVICES WITH MUNICIPALITY

THIS AGREEMENT RENEWAL, is entered into by and between the Public Defender Commission of Wood County, Ohio, with a mailing address of Wood County Public Defender, 123 N. Summit Street, Bowling Green, Ohio 43402, (hereinafter referred to as the "COUNTY PUBLIC DEFENDER"), and the City/Village of Brade , with a mailing address of 130 Main 54., P.O. Box 594 , Brade , Ohio 43406 (hereinafter referred to as the "CITY/VILLAGE").
WHEREAS, Section 3.1 of the previously executed Agreement set the contract term at one year beginning January 1, 20 <u>20</u> through December 31, 20 <u>20</u> , but allowed for renewal for an additional one-year terms upon execution of a proper resolution of each entity agreeing to the one year extension and appropriation of funding for the new contract year; and
NOW, THEREFORE, the parties, each in consideration of the promises made herein and in their prior Agreement, agree to the following:
1. The CITY/VILLAGE of <u>Brakes</u> and the COMMISSION hereby agree to extend their Agreement for Public Defender representation of indigents charged only with violations of municipal ordinances for an additional one-year term from January 1, 2021 to December 31, 2021.
2. The CITY/VILLAGE further represents that it has approved this extension of the Agreement by Resolution of Council, a copy of which is attached hereto, and appropriated the funds for the new contract year, as evidenced by the Fiscal Officer's Certification of the Availability of said Funds also attached hereto.
