

RESOLUTION NO. 15-2017 Passed 10/19, 2017

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE AND EXECUTION OF A CERTAIN RESIDENTIAL WATER AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, the Village owns and operates a municipal drinking water system for the benefit of the residents of the Village; and

WHEREAS, Village Residents Paul Brubaker-Garcia and Jamie Brubaker-Garcia recently purchased an unimproved lot within the Village, in an area not heretofore serviced by said municipal drinking water system; and

WHEREAS, said Brubaker-Garcias desire that the Village extend the municipal water system to said lot so that said Brubaker-Garcias may utilize and enjoy the benefits of clean, safe, municipally-furnished drinking water; and

WHEREAS, the Village wishes to extend its municipal water system to said Brubaker-Garcias' lot and beyond; and

WHEREAS, each of the parties are willing to bear certain expenses in order to achieve their individual objectives, as well as to benefit the common health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the Village; and

WHEREAS, after careful consideration of said proposal, Council finds that said project will economically benefit the Village, while at the same time, protect and promote the integrity of the Village water system, thus protecting the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BRADNER, COUNTY OF WOOD, AND STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Council of the Village of Bradner agrees to and approves the execution of said Residential Water Agreement with said Paul Brubaker-Garcia and Jamie N. Brubaker-Garcia.


SECTION 2. That the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to execute any and all such documents necessary to effectuate the agreement and to bind the Village.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution shall take immediate effect and be in force from the earliest date permitted by law.

SECTION 4. Copies of this Resolution were posted in not less than five of the most public places in the Village, as determined by Council, for the period required by law.

SECTION 5. All formal actions of Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution, and all deliberations of Council and any of its committees leading to such action were in meetings open to the public as required by law.
