

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE BOARD OF PUBLIC AFFAIRS TO FILL THE POSITION OF LINEMAN AT A COST WHICH EXCEEDS \$50,000.00 PER YEAR AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Public Affairs (BPA) has certain employees under its direction and control and pursuant to RC §735.29 shall hire, discharge, and manage and fix the compensation therefor; and

**WHEREAS**, the position of lineman within the Village is vacant; and

**WHEREAS**, after careful deliberation and investigation, the BPA has selected a candidate and wishes to hire him, with the amount of his annual compensation exceeding \$50,000.00 per year; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to RC §731.13, Council shall fix the compensation and bonds of all officers, clerks, and employees of the village except as otherwise provided by law; and

**WHEREAS**, in order to preserve the health, safety, and well-being of the municipal utilities, the employees thereof, and the general public, the passage of the Resolution as an emergency is appropriate and necessary.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BRADNER, COUNTY OF WOOD, AND STATE OF OHIO:

**Section 1.** That the Council of the Village of Bradner approves the hiring of Jerame Allgire as Village Lineman, effective March 19, 2018, upon the terms and conditions set-forth in Resolution 02-2018 of the Village of Bradner Board of Public Affairs.

**Section 2.** Copies of this Resolution were posted in not less than five of the most public places in the Village, as determined by Council, for the period required by law.


**Section 3.** All formal actions of Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution, and all deliberations of Council and any of its committees leading to such action were in meetings open to the public as required by law.


**Section 4.** This Resolution is an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the health and safety of the citizens of Bradner, Ohio, and therefore shall go into immediate effect upon the passage thereof and approval by the Mayor; the reason for the emergency is that it is urgently necessary to maintain the operation and safety of the Village electric power supply, thus preserving the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Bradner.
