

RESOLUTION NO. 01-2019

A RESOLUTION RATIFYING THE RULES OF COURT, BOND SCHEDULE, FINE SCHEDULE, AND COURT COSTS FOR THE BRADNER MAYOR'S COURT

WHEREAS, the Village has exercised its authority pursuant to RC §1905.01 by establishing a Mayor's Court to hear misdemeanor criminal and traffic cases charged under ordinances of the Village; and

WHEREAS, Article XVIII of the Ohio Constitution provides that "Municipalities shall have authority to exercise all powers of local self-government and to adopt and enforce within their limits such local police, sanitary and other similar regulations, as are not in conflict with general laws; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Revised Code does not provide specific procedure or requirements for the establishment of the rules of court, bond schedule, fine schedule, or court costs for Mayor's Courts within the State; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor of the Village, being statutorily vested with the judicial authority within the Mayor's Court of the Village, has established and adopted the rules of court, bond schedule, fine schedule, and court costs for the Village Mayor's Court; and

WHEREAS, while not expressly required by law, Council, after careful deliberation and investigation, has determined that said rules of court, bond schedule, fine schedule, and court costs for the Village Mayor's Court are fair, just and appropriate, and wish to ratify the same.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BRADNER, COUNTY OF WOOD, AND STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Council of the Village of Bradner hereby ratifies the Rules of Court, Bond Schedule, Fine Schedule, and Court Costs, as promulgated by the Mayor to be effective February 1, 2019.

SECTION 2. Copies of this Resolution were posted in not less than five of the most public places in the Village, as determined by Council, for the period required by law.

SECTION 3. All formal actions of Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution, and all deliberations of Council and any of its committees leading to such action were in meetings open to the public as required by law.

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
