AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BRADNER, WOOD COUNTY, OHIO TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 08-83 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, on or about April 21, 1983, the Council of the Village of Bradner passed Ordinance No. 08-83, which Ordinance created the, *inter alia*, the position of Deputy Marshall (also referred to as Patrol Officer), set the base pay therefor, and created certain terms and conditions for the employment thereof within the Village of Bradner Police Department; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to RC §715.05 and RC §737.16, Council of the Village has the authority to establish and maintain a Village Police Department and fix the hours and compensation therefor; and

WHEREAS, after careful consideration and evaluation of the finances of the Village and the need for additional police protection to maintain and preserve the health, safety, and general well-being of the citizens of the Village, Council has determined that it is necessary to amend certain regulations regarding the status and base pay for certain positions within the Village Police Department.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BRADNER, WOOD COUNTY, OHIO:

Section 1. That Ordinance 8-83 section 1 is amended in its entirety to read as follows:

“Municipal positions in the Village of Bradner, Ohio, shall hereafter include Marshall and Deputy Marshall.”

Section 2. That Ordinance 8-83 section 3 is amended in its entirety to read as follows:

“The compensation for Marshall or Deputy Marshall shall be established, fixed, or amended by Council by separate Ordinance.”


Section 3. All formal actions of Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance and all deliberations of Council to such action were in meetings open to the public as required by Law.

Section 4. This resolution constitutes an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace and safety of the residents of the Village of Bradner, and shall go into immediate effect upon the passage thereof. The reason for the emergency is that additional police employees are necessary to preserve the peace and safety of the Village.


Section 5. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time permitted by law.
