

ORDINANCE NO. 019-2022 passed 7-7-2022

**AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE 2-2022 OF  
THE VILLAGE OF BRADNER, WOOD COUNTY, OHIO  
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, on or about January 16, 2022, this Council passed Ordinance 2-2022 adopting the American Legal Publishing's Ohio Basic Code 2022 Edition; and

WHEREAS, after careful re-evaluation of the rules, regulations, and prohibitions contained therein, Council has determined them to no longer be in the best interests of the residents of the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BRADNER, WOOD COUNTY, OHIO:

**Section 1.** That Ordinance 2-2022 is hereby repealed in its entirety and shall be held for naught, having no effect or force in law.


**Section 2.** That, due to the repeal of said Ordinance 2-2022, Ordinance 3-2020 (passed February 6, 2020) shall remain in full force and effect.

**Section 3.** The reason for the emergency nature of this ordinance is that the conflict created by adopting conflicting codes must be immediately resolved to ensure the health, safety, and protection of the residents of the Village.

**Section 3.** All formal actions of Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance and all deliberations of Council and any of its committees leading to such action were in meetings open to the public as required by Law.


**Section 4.** That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time permitted by law.
