

RESOLUTION NO. 5-2022 Passed 7-7-2022, 2022

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PARTICIPATION IN AND APPLICATION FOR LOCAL PARK IMPROVEMENT GRANT PROGRAM AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Park Commissioners of the Wood County Park District have created a program to provide grants for permanent improvements to political subdivisions within Wood County that maintain public park facilities; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Bradner does maintain park facilities within Wood County which are open to and enjoyed by the public; and

**WHEREAS**, if awarded such a grant, the Village will be able to utilize said monies for permanent improvements to the park facilities within the Village for the enjoyment and use by the public.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BRADNER, COUNTY OF WOOD, AND STATE OF OHIO, WITH TWO-THIRDS OF THE MEMBERS VOTING IN FAVOR THEREOF:**

**SECTION 1.** That the Council of the Village of Bradner approves participation in the Local Park Improvement Program.

**SECTION 2.** That the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to execute and file an application with the Wood County Park District and to provide all information and documentation required to become eligible for possible funding assistance.

**SECTION 3.** That the Village of Bradner does agree to obligate the funds required to satisfactorily complete the proposed project and become eligible for reimbursement under the terms of the Grant Program.


**SECTION 4.** That this Resolution shall take immediate effect and be in force from the earliest date permitted by law.


**SECTION 5.** The reason for the emergency nature of this Resolution is due to the impending deadline for the application. There is insufficient time until the deadline to have three readings of this Resolution. A failure to apply for the grant would result in a lack of funding for the Village's parks which is detrimental to the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the Village.

**SECTION 5.** Copies of this Resolution were posted in not less than five of the most public places in the Village, as determined by Council, for the period required by law.

**SECTION 6.** All formal actions of Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution, and all deliberations of Council and any of its committees leading to such action were in meetings open to the public as required by law.
