

ORDINANCE 06-2025

**ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE 12-2021 OF THE VILLAGE OF  
BRADNER, WOOD COUNTY, OHIO REGARDING EMPLOYEE  
HOLIDAYS**

WHEREAS, on or about January 20, 2022, the Council of the Village of Bradner passed Ordinance 12-2021 which, inter alia, established Holidays and vacation times for certain employees of the Village, and

WHEREAS, after further deliberation and careful consideration and evaluation of the finances of the Village and the duties, qualifications, seniority, cost of living, and other relative factors related to said employees, Council has determined that it is necessary to further amend the regulation regarding the holiday vacation days for certain employees of the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BRADNER, COUNTY OF WOODS, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: That effective as of January 1, 2025, section 4(B) of Ordinance 12-2021 shall be amended to read as follows:

**B. HOLIDAYS**

1. Each employee shall be entitled to paid time-off for and on the following holidays:

- a) New Year's Day
- b) Memorial Day
- c) Independence Day
- d) Labor Day
- e) Thanksgiving Day
- f) Day after Thanksgiving
- g) Christmas Eve
- h) Christmas Day
- i) New Year's Eve
- j) The employee's actual birthday
- k) Martin Luther King Jr. Day
- l) Presidents' Day
- m) Juneteenth
- n) Veterans Day

In the event any of the foregoing holiday(s) fall on a Saturday or Sunday, then at the discretion of the Mayor, immediately preceding Friday or the immediately preceding Monday shall be substituted for the day-off.

2. To be eligible for holiday pay, the employee must work his/her scheduled shift the day before and the day after the holiday unless regularly scheduled off on either day, or if the employee has an excused absence.

3. Any employee not scheduled to work on any of the above-listed holidays who does work, shall have his or her wages computed on time and one-half rate.

SECTION 2: All other provisions of said Ordinance 12-2021 not specifically amended herein shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3: All formal actions of Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance and all deliberations of Council to such action were in meetings open to the public as required by law.

SECTION 4: That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time permitted by law.
