POLICE CHIEF'S REPORT- Chief Fairbanks- Chief was in attendance, all good his way and he asked council if they had anything for him? Linda reported she is still receiving calls about golf carts and that they are drinking while driving them. Cory asked her to direct any calls to him. He will also look into kids driving the carts as well as 4wheelers being driven on the streets.

FIRE CHIEF'S REPORT-Tom Wildman- Chief received an application from Conner Beck for the fire department. Conner will have his FF1 in October and will soon turn 18 years old. Tom reported he will be ordering 5 new sets of turnout gear as they are at their 10-year mark. Tom is currently working on an issue the fire dept is having with 114 Stahl St and open burning. The resident is being confrontational and not abiding by the rules for small camp fires. The fire dept. paid through their fire funds two rescue blocks for the Water Rescue. Unit 620 will be at the Tractor Pulls next weekend. Tom has had a lot of requests for July 18th next year's car show for an ox roast and possibly a band that evening.

BUSINESS OF THE MAYOR – Mayor James is continuing to work on the park grant. He would like to have information for placing a fountain at the pond.

BUSINESS OF THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR-John Linkey-John worked with AMP today to set a new pole out back of the town hall as the pole at 126 broke. The new pole is on our property line. Work is being done to set up 3-phase in alley between R/R street and Main St. There is a need of work to be done as some cutouts that have been up for 35 years have cracks in them. They are needing to be replaced before freezing weather. This will take a power outage for about 1 ½ hours for the village. When it gets scheduled, we will be sure to publicize it well to residents. John reported he will be off work the 15th and 21st of this month.

SOLICITOR’S REPORT-Reid Rothenbueller-not in attendance. Reid is intending to attend the 21st council meeting just to touch base with council.
